In 1967, Sonny saw the need in East Los Angeles and began going to the streets telling people about how God could set them free. He began taking junkies into his home. That was the beginning of Victory Outreach International. Today the ministry has over 500 churches and ministries in over 30 countries worldwide.

It wasn't until he attended his local community college where he met his writing professor, Dr. Leroy Robinson, one of the writers of the 70's movie "Car Wash", that he began to translate his visual editing skills into narrative form. Dr. Robinson quickly realized Aurelio's motivation for filmmaking and decided to lend him his personal 16mm bolex film camera to practice shooting on film. Soon after, local electronic music promoters began asking Aurelio to create visuals on film to project at electronic music events.

During this time, he also wrote and directed his first experimental feature film using his gathered experience in visuals and writing lessons he learned from his professor. Soon after filming his feature he moved to Los Angeles to pursue his film education at the University of Southern California. While at USC he produced 5 short films that received high remarks from his peers. He remembers one students saying that he made films that are daring, original and stood out from the rest. Something that 99% percent of students at school just didn't do.

While at school he worked at LATV, a Los Angeles television network labeled as the music television network for Latino Americans. There he worked as an editor, cameraman, producer and director for various departments including the promotions department and directed music videos under the label Universal Music Latino.

Aurelio was hired to direct the film story of Sonny Argonzoni, the film is currently in the post-production stages. Currently, Aurelio in the process of writing his first feature that he plans to raise money and make it into his first official feature film.





**ACTRESS "JULIE"** 




